

DO YOU CONSIDER BIRTH A MEDICAL EVENT OR PHYSIOLOGICAL PROCESS?

I believe birth is much like sleeping. You do not need to teach a woman how to give birth. Women may need education around how birth works and they may need support in labor to get through the intensity but birth is a physiological process that will happen when both mom and baby are ready.



WHAT IF MY BIRTH PLAN CHANGES?

My job as your doula is to show you support in all the decisions you make in regards to your birth. If you have a change of mind or heart I will support you in that decision. I trust that you will be well educated on all your options and that you know what is best for you and your baby. I will stand with you through any and all changes.

WHAT POSTPARTUM SUPPORT LOOKS LIKE

I believe that postpartum support is crucial to the health and well being of the whole family. Mothers need to be taken care of so that they have the ability to care for their babies. My birth packages include postpartum support for this reason.

HOW SOON SHOULD I HIRE A DOULA?

You can never experience too much support too early. I begin working with most of my clients in the second trimester, but have had many clients prep earlier for their births!



DOES A DOULA REPLACE MY PARTNER'S ROLE?

No. I am here to support both you and your partner! Your partner and I will collaborate as a team to make the best of your birth experience.

PREGNANCY SUPPORT
